

Greeting Team

First impressions are important!

Staff on this team are the faces visitors first see when they come into our church. They communicate who we are as a group of believers, and what we practice.

Our greeters are the embodiment of the life-changing God-encounters people can expect at Gateway!

The greeting team has two areas: "door greeters" and "hosts".

Door Greeters - People first encounter these greeters when they approach or enter the facility. Beyond a warm smile and handing out bulletins, these greeters are there to identify newcomers and make them feel welcome, as well as help direct people to the main hall, nursery and bathrooms.

Hosts - Working in the main sanctuary, their role is multifaceted. Much like at any social function, our hosts keep an eye out for new guests and help them feel at home during our service. They offer friendly conversation, assist with seating, and offer guests coffee or tea. As the eyes and ears in the main hall, they identify any issues that need to be brought to a leader's attention. For newcomers with children, hosts explain our procedure for children's ministry, and if guests are interested, connects them with someone who can give them a tour of the children's area.

Team Requirements

- Be available on a monthly basis to be scheduled for hosting or door greeting.
- Attend our pre-service prayer starting at 10:10 a.m. and be in place for greeting from 10:20 a.m. to 10:50 a.m.
- Business-casual attire and a friendly face!
