

Video Streaming – What is Periscope and how to use it

Periscope is a video streaming service. That is, it allows you to create video using a smart phone and have other people view it as you're filming. At Gateway we're using this broadcasting capability to create live video of our services (and other events, or moments to capture) and to store this video using a third party service for later viewing.

- By downloading the [Periscope App](#) you can view video of our service while we're recording it (but don't stay home, we'd rather you attend!), and also be notified and tune in whenever we're creating a broadcast. Periscope only works on a smart phone device.
- You can see the [archive of our broadcasts here](#) to catch a service you may have missed, or to re-hear/view a message or other video snippet we've recorded. You can access this archive from any web browser – phone or PC.

Periscope instructions for you and your phone:

1. Go to the App Store and download Periscope
2. Follow instructions to set up a Periscope account. This step works easiest on an iOS platform combined with a Twitter account. If using an Android or setting up an account without Twitter, follow the instructions to use via a phone number.
3. Once you have set up your Periscope account and have logged in, select the icon on the bottom right (three "people"), search (magnifying glass) for Gateway
4. When you have landed on the Gateway page, select "follow"
5. Once you begin following Gateway you will be notified every time Gateway begins broadcasting on Periscope
6. To watch the broadcast just click on it when it appears
