

How do we learn about God? Well, apart from reading our Bibles and praying for wisdom, we can ask questions. This series of lessons looks at some of the questions kids can have about God. This lesson outline is good for children of any age. Complete anything in this lesson that you know your child can understand and enjoy.

### 2. TODAY'S ANSWER - HERE'S THE SUMMARY

Today's Answer isn't specific to one Bible Story, but God's omnipresence (God is everywhere) is found as a theme throughout Scripture. Here is a read-aloud story about a mom explaining God's bigness to her son:

After watching the story, talk about these main concepts, asking your child(ren) questions to ensure basic understanding:

Is anything bigger than God? *No, He's bigger than anything*

Why is God so big? *Answers will vary -- so He can take care of us, so He can defeat the devil, so He can make the world, are all common answers*

### 3. TODAY'S ANSWER - FURTHER STUDY

Also, here are some verses that talk about God's size. Read and talk about as many as your children have attention for.

1) Job 38:5 - If God measured the universe with a "measuring line" (today's equivalent would be a measuring tape), then how big would He have to be?

2) Psalm 139:7 - If there's no where you can go away from God, it must be because He's everywhere, He's just that big.

3) 2 Chron 2:6 - If we could build a house for God, it would have to be bigger than the highest heavens, and even then it wouldn't be big enough for Him!

### 4. TODAY'S MEMORY VERSE

2 Chronicles 2:6 Not even the highest heavens can contain Him!

Start by saying the verse in a whisper, and then get louder with each time you say it!
