

## Lessons on the Christian Life Lesson 6: Telling Others about Jesus

I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

John 10:10





Just before Jesus left this earth, He had some very important times with His disciples. One of the last things He told them was, "Go into all the world and preach the *gospel* to every creature."

Then He filled them with the Holy Spirit's power so they could do that. They not only preached the gospel, they healed the sick, cast out devils and did mighty minacles as they had seen Jesus do.

- 1. We are surrounded by people every day who don't know what to do to go to heaven when they die. Some people we see all the time would really love to be sure they're not going to hell. And WE have their answer. What is their answer? What do they have to do in order to know they will go to heaven when they die?
- **2.** At least two things are very important for them to know. God said our message is: "God is not holding your sins against you" (2 Cor. 5:19). They need to know GOD IS NOT MAD AT THEM. All they have to do is ask His forgiveness for their sins and He will instantly forgive them all. It is very important to stress that they **ask for forgiveness**.
