DALM SUNDAY CRAFT




Make your own palm branches!


Decorate a rectangular sheet of paper with as much green as you can.
Use green markers, crayons, magazine cut outs of green things, or even green stickers. You can also use a green piece of paper for this craft.

Fold your paper along the diagonal.

Trim off the corners so you
just have one large triangle.



Step 3



Cut a number of horizontal (or slightly curved) lines from the edges of the page towards the fold, making thin strips of paper.

Note: Be careful to stay about 1 cm away from the fold! Cut until you pass the top corner. Then cut parallel to the fold about 1 cm away. (This will make your stem.)

cut off every other strip, alternating on other side

Step 5

Open up your palm branch! Cut off every other paper strip close to the stem on one side of your branch. Alternate which strips you cut on the other side. (See thick lines in the picture.)

Tape your stem to a thin wooden dowling or pencil, for added strength. Wave your new palm branch in the air and shout, "Hosanna to the King!"
